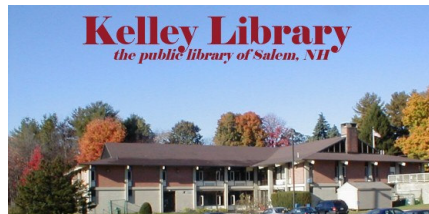

WHY MOBILE BOOKS

The Kelley Library has been providing delivery of library materials to homebound seniors in Salem for many years. Based on the success of the program and due to the vision of volunteer Joan Fardella, the program has expanded to reach more homebound residents of our community.

A public library is a place of ideas, a community resource and a source of materials for entertainment, information and life-long learning. It is vital to make sure that all residents have access to a library. When the person can't come to the library due to health problems, age, physical disabilities and limitations, the library must come to the person.

The Library's mission is 'Dedicated to Serving You'. Outreach, such as Mobile Books, is a natural result of this mission.



Reading keeps the mind active, promotes a sense of well being key to a healthier, happier life.

Who can get this service?

- This service is available to Salem residents of any age who are truly homebound, including seniors, physically disabled, homebound permanently or temporarily due to illness or injury.



How do I get started?

- Call or visit the library to arrange for an initial home visit so you can meet Joan, talk about your interests and set up a schedule.

What kind of library materials can I get?

- Right now we are limiting to books and audiobooks. We will consider adding other formats as the program develops. Large print and standard print are available.

How often will they be delivered?

- Your selections will be delivered once every two weeks.

What if I am not home?

- Joan will be calling the day before to remind you of her next visit. If you are going to be away, you can call and let her know. If there is an emergency, Joan will renew your books and get in touch with you later.

What if the books are overdue?

- Don't worry about overdues, Joan will renew when a visit is impossible for whatever reason. We will ask for another contact to help us retrieve books should you be away for any length of time.
